

# AAT Syllabus Change 2022

**IMPORTANT NOTICE – anyone that enrolls on the AQ2016 courses now and 31<sup>st</sup> August must register as an AAT student with AAT as soon as possible as you only have until 31<sup>st</sup> August 2022 to do this (see key dates below)**

**As explained in all the course information students must register as a student member of the AAT to study and achieve these qualifications.**

AAT regularly change their syllabus to ensure that their suite of Qualifications is kept up to date, meeting the needs of employers and ensuring trainees are prepared for effective roles in the evolving business environment.

Their latest change is going to come into action on the 1<sup>st</sup> of September 2022 when they will be moving over from “AQ2016” to ‘Q2022’.

This has been delayed twice from the original September 2021 date due to COVID and again due to insufficient time to fully test their new assessment platform ATLAS cloud.

## Some Key Dates & Deadlines

**31st August 2022 – Last day for membership registration under the AQ2016 syllabus.**

**1st September 2022 – All membership registrations will be for the Q2022 syllabus from this date.**

**30th September 2023 – Last opportunity to sit assessments on any of the current Access level qualifications and AQ2016 Foundation, Advanced and Professional level qualifications. You'll need to ensure you have planned synoptic assessment activity in line with the synoptic assessment schedule.**

**30 November 2023: Final certificate for all Access, Foundation, Advanced and Professional level qualifications.**
